Interested Community Members Invited to Serve on Banner Program Committee Honoring Active-duty Armed Service Personnel

Last fall, the Windsor Town Council supported the exploration of establishing an Armed Forces Banner program in Windsor. The program would enable the community to recognize and honor individuals on active duty in the military by sponsoring banners that would be hung in a prominent place in the Town. Eligible candidates for such recognition must have been residents, or have family who are residents, of Windsor and be currently serving in one of the service branches of the U.S. Armed Forces.

The Council requested that the Parks and Recreation Commission study the proposal and to return a recommendation to the Council. At its meeting last week, the Parks and Recreation Commission appointed Commissioners John Cain and Scott Huberts to a Committee to formulate detailed plans for the banner program. The Commission has issued an invitation to interested community members to serve on the committee. It is anticipated that the first meeting will be held in March.
