Town Green Bench Donated in Memory of Windsor Community Activist and Volunteer Marv Stubbs

The Windsor Town Council has donated a commemorative bench and plaque in memory of the late Windsor community activist and volunteer, Marv Stubbs. The bench and plaque have been installed near the Historical Timeline Walk where they are guarded by the American, MIA/POW and California flags that were installed on the Town Green with Mr. Stubb's coordination. This seems appropriate, as he was a veteran of both the Korean and Vietnam wars who loved and served his country and his community.

Mr. Stubbs, who passed away in September this year, was a charter member of the Windsor Kiwanis Club and of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 768. He was the co-chairman of Citizens for Windsor during the Town's incorporation and a former board member of the Windsor Union School District.

The Town's Commemorative Park Amenity Program provides opportunities for citizens to recognize a special person, event, group or organization while enhancing local parks with amenities for the enjoyment of the Town's citizens and visitors.
