Historical Walking Tour(s) (Old Downtown Windsor)

9 to 10:30 a.m. and 2 to 3:30 p.m. (.6 mile)

An historical tour of Old Town Windsor led by Steve Lehmann, President of the Windsor Historical Society and Town of Windsor Historian. The walk is for all ages and will be outdoors along city streets. The tour will be in English. Meet at the Snoopy “Rainbow Joe” Statue on Windsor Town Green, corner of McClelland Drive and Market Street.
