Windsor, California (August 9, 2011) – Wall Street Sidewalk Improvements Complete

Windsor, California (August 9, 2011) – Please join us as we celebrate the completion of the Wall Street Sidewalk Improvement Project. A ribbon cutting will be held on Tuesday August 16th at 5:30 p.m. at the corner of Wall Street and Windsor Road.

The Wall Street Sidewalk Improvement Project was started in 2009 and passed through several design configurations before construction was completed in July of 2011. Funding for the project was provided by a combination of Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) through the Sonoma County Community Development Commission and Town of Windsor Redevelopment Agency funds. Curb, gutter, water lateral, street light conduit, storm drain and sidewalk improvements were installed along the south side of Wall Street from Windsor Road to the west end of Wall Street at the pedestrian entrance to Keiser Park. All improvements were constructed to current American with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements providing an accessible route to Keiser Park from the Wall Street and Windsor Road neighborhoods near the High School. The total construction cost for the project was approximately \$208,000.

The project presented several challenges such as vehicle and pedestrian access to existing homes and the removal and replacement of existing fences. Geoff Hornsby provided right-of-way services. The project was designed by Coastland Civil Engineering, Inc. Ghilotti Construction along with their subcontractors including Brown Electric and Ahlborn Fencing constructed the Sidewalk Improvement Project. Green Valley Consulting Engineers provided construction management and inspection.
