

RESOLUTION NO. 3142-14

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
ADOPTING THE CITY OF SANTA ROSA/COUNTY OF SONOMA LOW IMPACT
DEVELOPMENT TECHNICAL DESIGN MANUAL, DATED AUGUST 2011, AND
SUBSEQUENT MANUAL UPDATES, TO REDUCE POLLUTANTS IN STORM WATER
PURSUANT TO TITLE IX, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 9-4-300(C) OF THE TOWN OF
WINDSOR MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, Title IX, Chapter 4, Section 9-4-300(c) of the Town of Windsor Municipal Code provides for the adoption of requirements for reducing pollutants in storm water from new development and reconstruction projects; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2010, the Town Council adopted an Ordinance amending Title IX, Section 9-3-300 (c) of the Town of Windsor Municipal Code pertaining to requirements for reducing pollutants in storm water; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2010, the Town Council also adopted Resolution No. 2672-10, which adopted the Guidelines for the Standard Urban Storm Water Management Plan (2005 SUSMP), dated June 3, 2005, as prepared for the County of Sonoma, City of Santa Rosa and the Russian River Watershed Association; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Rosa and County of Sonoma developed additional requirements for reducing pollutants in storm water in a document titled Low Impact Development Technical Design Manual (LID Manual), dated August 2011; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2013, the Town Council authorized the Town Manager to submit a letter of intent to the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) indicating the Town would participate in the Santa Rosa Area Phase I Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit (Phase I NPDES Permit); and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2013, the Town Council also acknowledged that the Town would be required to adopt the LID Manual within the time frame approved by the Regional Board, but no later than December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the LID Manual has been adopted and widely used by the City of Santa Rosa and County of Sonoma to meet their Phase I NPDES Permit requirements for post-construction storm water treatment; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Board has proposed that both the Phase I and Phase II communities within the Russian River Watershed adopt the LID Manual for area wide consistency in post construction water quality standards; and

WHEREAS, numerous Phase I and Phase II communities within the Russian River Watershed have recently adopted the LID Manual to promote region wide consistency in post construction storm water treatment; and


WHEREAS, the LID Manual has been reviewed and determined to be appropriate for use by new development and reconstruction projects in the Town of Windsor to meet the Town's Phase I NPDES Permit requirements for treatment of post construction storm water.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby adopts the LID Manual, dated August 2011, and subsequent manual updates, to reduce pollutants in storm water pursuant to Title IX, Section 9-3-300 (c) of the Town of Windsor Municipal Code; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution and the LID Manual shall take effect and be in full force on December 31, 2014 and shall supersede Resolution No. 2672-10 and the 2005 SUSMP.
