

RESOLUTION NO. 3382-17

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
APPROVING THE APPLICATION TO NOMINATE THE CUNNINGHAM-HEMBREE
ESTATE TO THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES WITH THE
UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR NATIONAL PARK SERVICE
AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE APPLICATION ON
BEHALF OF TOWN**

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor owns the Cunningham House, circa 1850, and the Hembree House and gardens, circa 1931, located on Foxwood Drive, adjacent to the Windsor Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes the two homes to be of local historical significance, and has included them in the Town's Historical Designation District; and

WHEREAS, the Town's intent is to preserve and protect sites and structures that have contributed to Windsor's character and identity; and

WHEREAS, the Town is committed to preserving the historic resource and making it available to the community; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Windsor Historical Society is to fund, maintain, renovate and operate the historical grounds as a museum and association in order to collect, store and display historical artifacts, and share the history and culture of the Windsor area; and

WHEREAS, the Town leases the Cunningham House and the Hembree House Cultural Center to the Windsor Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, George Greeott gifted \$10,000 to the Town of Windsor for promoting the Cunningham-Hembree Estate, and registration of the Estate as a Historic Place will facilitate such promotion.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby approves the application to nominate the Cunningham-Hembree Estate to the National Register of Historic Places with the United States Department of the Interior National Park Service and authorizes the Town Manager to submit the application on behalf of Town.
