

RESOLUTION NO. 3417-17

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR TO
RENEW THE AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES WITH THE
COUNTY OF SONOMA**

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor (“Town”) desires to contract with the County of Sonoma (“County”) for the performance of law enforcement functions within the Town's municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the County is capable of rendering such services under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, such contracts are authorized by California Government Code, Section 51301; and

WHEREAS, the existing agreement for law enforcement services went into effect July 1, 2008, at 12:00 A.M. and shall terminate at 11:59 P.M. on June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, with formal action by the Town Council and the County Board of Supervisors, the Agreement shall be renewable for successive periods of not to exceed ten years each.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby expresses its desire to renew the Agreement for one year pursuant to “Section 28. Term of Agreement”; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Manager is authorized to submit this resolution, on behalf of the Town Council, to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors by December 31, 2017; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that subsequent to written notification of acceptance by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, the Town Manager is authorized to execute an Amendment extending the term of the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the County of Sonoma for one year, on substantially the same terms and conditions contained in the Agreement.
