

RESOLUTION NO. 3465-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
AUTHORIZING DESIGNATION OF APPLICANT'S AGENT FOR
NON-STATE AGENCIES**

WHEREAS, as a result of the October 2017 Sonoma and Napa counties wildfire disaster number 4344, the Town has submitted a reimbursement request to FEMA for qualifying expenses totaling \$33,447 under the Town's Cal OES ID 097-85922, of which up to 75% is eligible for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor is required to submit a Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies (Cal OES form 130) to be eligible to receive this funding; and

WHEREAS, this Designation will be a universal resolution and is effective for all open and future disasters up to three years following the effective date listed below; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager will be authorized to execute for and on behalf of the Town of Windsor the necessary forms, applications, assurances and agreements to obtain certain federal financial assistance under Public Law 93-288.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby resolves as follows:

1. The Town Manager is authorized to execute for and on behalf of the Town of Windsor and the Windsor Water District, public entities established under the laws of the State of California, the State of California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) form #130 and to file it with Cal OES for the purposes of obtaining certain federal financial assistance under Public Law 93-288 as amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act.
2. The Town Manager is authorized to provide to Cal OES for all matters pertaining to such state disaster assistance the assurances and agreements required.
3. This is a universal resolution and is effective for all open and future disasters up to three (3) years following the date of approval below.
