

RESOLUTION NO. 3472-18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
REJECTING THE NON-RESPONSIVE BID FROM FRITTS FORD AND
AWARD THE BID TO CORNING FORD, THE LOWEST RESPONSIVE BIDDER, FOR
THE FORD F-550 AERIAL LIFT UTILITY VEHICLE, FOR THE AMOUNT OF
\$124,450.37, AND AUTHORIZE THE TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
PURCHASE ORDER AND ANY BUDGET INCREASES UP TO 10 PERCENT OF THE
ORIGINAL PURCHASE AMOUNT**

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2017, the Town Council adopted the Fiscal Year 2017-19 budget; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2017, the Town Council adopted the Capital Replacement Program for Fiscal Year 2017-2022 including the purchase of an aerial lift utility vehicle in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year; and

WHEREAS, a request for quote was advertised on the Town's website as well as mailed to several local vendors that could provide the type of vehicle specified; and

WHEREAS, six quotes were received from vendors throughout California ranging from \$124,275.33 to \$142,927.84; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder was Fritts Ford with a quote of \$124,275.33; and

WHEREAS, upon further review of the Fritts Ford quote, staff found several deficiencies in the alternate equipment that Fritts specified, as described in the accompanying agenda report; and

WHEREAS, staff has reviewed the deficiencies and determined that they are sufficiently significant to deem the Fritts Ford quote as nonresponsive; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder is Corning Ford with a responsive quote of \$124,450.37.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby rejects the quote from Fritts Ford, accepts the lowest responsive quote from Corning Ford, and authorizes the Town Manager to execute a purchase order in the amount of \$124,450.37 and any budget increase up to 10% of the purchase amount.
