

**RESOLUTION NO. 3516-19**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR  
SUPPORTING A ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT  
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SONOMA AND AUTHORIZING  
THE INTERIM TOWN MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO  
EXTEND THE SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR A ONE-YEAR PERIOD**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Windsor (“Town”) desires to contract with the County of Sonoma (“County”) for the performance of law enforcement functions within the Town's municipal boundaries; and

**WHEREAS**, the County is capable of rendering such services under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, such contracts are authorized by California Government Code, Section 51301; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing agreement for law enforcement services went into effect July 1, 2018, at 12:00 A.M. and shall terminate at 11:59 P.M. on June 30, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, with formal action by the Town Council and the County Board of Supervisors, the Agreement shall be renewable for successive periods of not to exceed ten years each.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor hereby expresses its desire to renew the Agreement for one year pursuant to “Section 28. Term of Agreement”; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Interim Town Manager is authorized to submit this resolution, on behalf of the Town Council, to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Interim Town Manager is authorized to execute the second amendment to agreement for law enforcement services between the County of Sonoma and the Town of Windsor.
