

RESOLUTION NO. 3510-19

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF A LIST OF PROJECTS
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 FUNDED BY SENATE BILL 1,
ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017, to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Windsor are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor (Town) must adopt a list of projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1 by resolution, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the Town will receive an estimated \$460,000 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2019-20 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the third year in which the Town is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the Town to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that could not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the Town used the Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the 2019-2020 Town-Wide Street Resurfacing Project consists of slurry seal of residential streets in the southeast quadrant of the town, the Elsbree neighborhood in the northeast, and the old downtown area of Windsor; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the Town maintain and rehabilitate approximately 75 streets (or 182,000 square yards of street surface) and add active transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the Town's streets and roads are in good condition and this revenue will help increase the overall quality of the Town's road system and over the next decade will bring the Town's streets and roads into an excellent condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in the Town’s local streets and road infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the following list of proposed projects will be funded in-part or solely with Fiscal Year 2019-20 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

1. The 2019-2020 Town-Wide Street Resurfacing Project consists of slurry seal of residential streets in the southeast quadrant of the town, the Elsbree neighborhood in the northeast, and the old downtown area of Windsor. The project will improve the quality of bicycle and pedestrian facilities and safety for all users by maintaining the pavement. The estimated useful life of the planned improvements is expected to be ten years. The proposed project is scheduled to begin construction July 2019 and be completed by September 2019.

2. The Windsor River Road/Windsor Road Intersection Improvement Project consists of construction of a roundabout and pedestrian crossing safety improvements. The pedestrian rail crossing safety improvements are required by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) as there are currently no barriers separating pedestrians from the railroad tracks. The project will improve vehicular, bicycle, and pedestrian circulation. The estimated useful life of the planned improvements is expected to be twenty years. The proposed project is scheduled to begin construction July 2020 and be completed by September 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the Town of Windsor authorizes the submittal of a list of projects for Fiscal Year 2019-20 funded by Senate Bill 1 Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017.
