

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR  
AMENDING TITLE III ARTICLE 19 SECTIONS 100 AND 135 (E) OF THE  
MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR  
PERTAINING TO CIVIL DEFENSE AND DISASTER**

**THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS  
FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** Title 3 Chapter 19 Article 1 Sections 3-19-100 and 3-19-135(e) of the Town Code (Ordinance No.96-91) are amended to read as follows:

**Article 100. General**

**3-19-100 Purpose**

The purpose of this chapter is to comply with the provisions of the California Emergency Services Act, Title Two, Division One, Chapter Seven of the Government Code of the State of California (commencing with Section 8550): to provide for the preparation and carrying out the plans for the protection of persons and property within the Town of Windsor in the event of an emergency; to provide for the mitigation of the effects of natural, man-made, or war-caused emergencies which result in conditions of disaster or extreme peril to life, property, or the resources of the Town of Windsor; and to create an organization based on the Standardized Emergency Management System (SEMS)/National Incident Management System (NIMS).

**3-19-135 Powers and Duties of the Emergency Council.**

**ITEM E.** The Emergency Council may meet annually or sooner if needed to review or exercise the town emergency plan.

**SECTION 2. Effective Date and Publication.**

Within 15 days from and after adoption, this Ordinance shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with California Government Code section 36933. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
