## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Town of Windsor Town Council will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, August 21, 2019 at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard**, in the Civic Center Council Chambers, Building 400, 9291 Old Redwood Highway, Windsor, CA. The Town Council will consider amending Title 1, Chapter 2, Article 2 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Windsor, "District Elections," to incorporate newly annexed territory north of Arata Lane into Town Council District 2.

This ordinance will incorporate newly annexed property into the nearest existing Council district without changing the boundaries of other Council district boundaries. The Town of Windsor encourages interested parties to attend public hearings and comment on the issues being discussed. If you wish to provide testimony and are unable to attend the meeting, written comments delivered to the Town Clerk's Office prior to the hearing will be made a part of the public record.

Prior to the hearing, staff reports and agendas may be requested from the Town Clerk's Office for a minimal fee to recover reproduction costs and they are also accessible on the Town's website prior to the Town Council meeting at [www.townofwindsor.com](http://www.townofwindsor.com).
