

RESOLUTION NO. 2057-07

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR ADOPTING THE APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007-08**

WHEREAS, the voters of the State of California in November 1979 approved Proposition 4, commonly know as the Gann Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the Proposition created Article XIII B of the California State Constitution placing limits on the amount of revenue which can be spent by all entities of government; and

WHEREAS, these limits require a municipality to determine an appropriations limit each year in accordance with a formula set forth by state law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor does hereby adjust the Town's provisional limit by the population (1.0183) and CPI (1.0442) factors for fiscal year 2007-08 to determine a limit of \$12,607,790 for fiscal year 2007-08.


