

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-354

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
AMENDING TITLE IV, CHAPTER 5, ARTICLE 1 OF THE
CODE OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR TO REMOVE THIRD STREET FROM THE
LIST OF ESTABLISHED NO PARKING ZONES**

WHEREAS, in 1992, when the Town was formed, existing No Parking Zones established by the County of Sonoma were incorporated into Town's Municipal Code (Code) and a No Parking Zone was established on Third Street; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2001, Council accepted the Franklin Area Street Improvements which installed curb and gutter and widened Third Street from 18 feet to 36 feet; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2021, staff conducted a field review of the conditions on Third Street and finds that it would be appropriate to allow parking on both sides of the street since the width is adequate (36') and sight lines are clear.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 4-5-100 of the Windsor Town Code, No Parking Zones Established, is amended to remove Third Street from the established No Parking Zones as follows (with deletions in ~~strike through~~):

“4-5-100 - No Parking Zones Established.

No parking zones have been established in the following locations. No person shall park a vehicle in the area designated.

Name of Street	Side	Location
”		
Third Street	a. North	Beginning at the northerly right of way of Old Redwood Highway and extending in a northerly direction on the easterly side of the street to the southerly right of way of Franklin Street, a distance of approximately 300 feet.
	b. North	Beginning at the northerly right of way of Old Redwood Highway and extending in a northerly direction on the westerly side of the street for a distance of 180 feet.”

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provision, clause, sentence, section, word, or part thereof is held illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or inapplicable to any person or circumstance, such holding shall not affect or impair any of the remaining


provisions, clauses, sentences, sections, words, or parts thereof, or their applicability to other persons or circumstances.

SECTION 3. Approval of the Ordinance is exempt from environmental review in accordance California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines section 15061(b)(3), the general exemption for projects with no potential for significant effect on the environment. As a minor text amendment, it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the Ordinance will have a significant effect on the environment.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take affect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage. The Town Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published or be posted in at least three (3) public places in Town in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code of the State of California.
