The Town of Windsor is seeking applicants to fill three (3) expired seats on the Public Art Advisory Commission. Appointed seats will serve a two-year term, expiring in December 2024.

PUBLIC ART ADVISORY COMMISSION

The **Public Art Advisory Commission** serves in an advisory capacity to the Town Council and the Parks and Recreation Director, or their designee, to support the Town by establishing Windsor as an art destination that raises the potential for education, innovation, collaborative community engagement and cultural exploration. To be eligible for appointment to the Commission, members shall be residents of Sonoma County, and are preferred to be residents of the Town; Youth Commissioners must have a junior (11th grade) or senior (12th grade) status. Youth seats will be appointed by Council majority vote, will hold a non-voting status with an “input only” capacity, and will serve a one-year term commencing in June. The Public Art Advisory Commission **meets the fourth Wednesday of the month at 4:30 p.m.**, normally in the Windsor Civic Center Council Chambers, 9291 Old Redwood Highway, Building 400, Windsor, CA.
