

ORDINANCE NO. 2010-264

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
AMENDING TITLE III, CHAPTER 22 (MESSAGE ESTABLISHMENTS),
SECTION 3-22-110 (PERMIT REQUIRED), SECTION 3-22-115 (DISPLAY OF
PERMITS), AND SECTION 3-22-170 (VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES)
REGARDING COMPLIANCE WITH SB 371 VOLUNTARY
STATE CERTIFICATION FOR MASSAGE THERAPISTS AND
PRACTITIONERS**

**THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Title III, Chapter 22 (Massage Establishments), Section 3-22-110 Permit Required to comply with SB 731 is amended as follows:

Section 3-22-110 title shall be amended to read "Permit/Certificate Required":

Section 3-22-110 shall be amended to add the following:

- c. Massage Practitioners/Therapist Certificate: Massage practitioners/therapists that have a valid Certificate issued by the Massage Therapy Organization pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 4600 et. seq. shall provide a copy of the certificate to be held on file with the Town. Valid certifications shall exempt the practitioner/therapist from obtaining a Town Massage Practitioner Permit.

Section 3-22-135 title shall be amended to read "Display of Permits/Certification"

Section 3-22-135 shall be amended to add the following:

In the event that a Certificate is issued by the Massage Therapy Organization as identified in Section 3-22-110, all practitioners/therapist certificates shall be displayed and available for inspection during regular business hours.

Section 3-22-170 shall be amended to read as follows:

Any violation of this chapter may be enforced by any remedy available to the Town under this Code or as provided by State law.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any article, section, subsection sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or exhibit hereto is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the offending portion shall be severed and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage. The Town Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published or be posted in at least three (3) public places in Town in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code of the State of California.
