

RESOLUTION NO. 2816-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR FOR PAYING AND REPORTING THE VALUE OF
EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC
EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, the Town of Windsor (“the Town”) has the authority to implement Government Code Section 20636(c) (4) pursuant to Section 20691; and

WHEREAS, the Town has a written labor policy or agreement which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the employer, and reported as additional compensation; and

WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement Section 20691 is the adoption by the Town Council of the Town of Windsor of a Resolution to commence paying and reporting the value of said Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC) to CalPERS; pursuant to CCR title 2 section 571 (a) (1); and

WHEREAS, the Town has identified the following conditions for the purpose of its election to pay EPMC;

- This benefit shall apply to:
 1. Town of Windsor Management Employees Group (MEG) job classifications: Accounting Supervisor, Assistant Engineer, Assistant Town Engineer, Associate Civil Engineer, Associate Planner, Building Official, Finance Manager, Management Analyst, Parks & Facilities Division Manager, Principal Civil Engineer, Project Manager, Public Works Manager, Recreation Program Manager, Recreation Program Supervisor, Senior Civil Engineer, Senior Management Analyst, Senior Planner, and Water Conservation Program Coordinator
 2. Confidential job classifications: Human Resources Analyst and Human Resources Manager
 3. Executive management job classifications: Administrative Services Director, Assistant Town Manager, Parks and Recreation Director, Planning and Building Director, Public Works Director/Town Engineer, and Town Clerk
 4. Town Manager

- This benefit shall consist of paying four percent (4%) of the normal contributions as

EPMC, and reporting the same four percent (4%) of compensation earnable (excluding Government Code Section 20636(c)(4)) as additional compensation.

- The effective date of this Resolution shall be July 1, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor, elects to pay and report the value of EPMC, as set forth above.


