**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF WINDSOR
APPROVING AN EQUITABLE SHARING AGREEMENT WITH THE U.S.
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER TO
EXECUTE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN**

WHEREAS, the Comprehensive Crime Act of 1984 authorizes federal officials to share assets seized as a result of criminal investigations through an Equitable Sharing Agreement.

WHEREAS, the Equitable Sharing Agreement fosters cooperation among federal, state, and local agencies.

WHEREAS, the Equitable Sharing Agreement will allow the Windsor Police Department to access funds that have been seized as a result of criminal investigations.

WHEREAS, the equitably shared funds will enhance the effectiveness of the Windsor Police Department by providing additional training and equipment for officers, as well as support community based programs centered on drug and gang awareness.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Windsor, authorizes the Town Manager to execute an Equitable Sharing Agreement with the United States Department of Justice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Council authorizes the Administrative Services Director to disburse all proper expenses from the asset forfeiture fund as authorized by the Town Manager in accordance with the Equitable Sharing Agreement guidelines.
